Organizing Information with Power Notes

To organize your History Day research information, consider using power notes. This format will not only help you organize your information for your project, but also let you see where you might need more information. Here are some guidelines to follow:

- ~Title is your **Project Title** and **Subtitle**
- ~Power 1 is your **Thesis Statement**
- ~Power 2s are your **Research Questions**
- ~Power 3s are basic **Answers** to your research questions
- ~Power 4s are **Supporting Details** for your answers

The basic format of power notes for your History Day project looks like this:

Project Title: Subtitle

- 1. Thesis Statement:
 - 2. Research Question 1
 - 3. Answer
 - 4. Supporting Details
 - 4. Use as many as you need for Supporting Details
 - 3. Answer
 - 3. Use as many as you need for Answers
 - 2. Research Question 2
 - 2. Use as many as you need for Research Questions
